

How Does the Program Work?

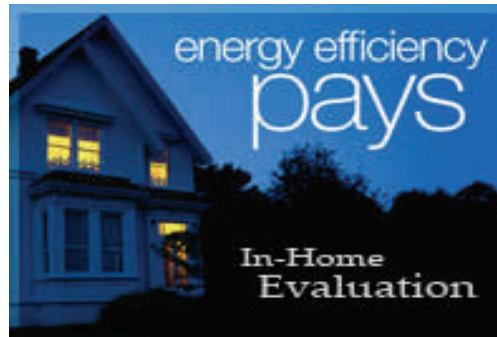
Here is a step-by-step breakdown of how you can take advantage of this program to start saving money on your energy costs.

1. Call AEC and request your *In Home Energy Evaluation*.
2. Our trained energy evaluator will contact you to schedule & complete your evaluation. A charge of \$50.00 will be applied for this service.
3. You decide which suggested improvements you want to make and select a TVA/AEC qualified weatherization contractor to perform the work. If you proceed with any or all of the recommendations, the \$50.00 charge is refunded in full.
4. The contractor will perform the work and you pay the contractor for the work. (you may perform some qualifying improvements yourself.)
5. Submit your paid receipts to AEC. (must total \$150.00 minimum)
6. An energy evaluator will contact you to schedule and perform a follow-up inspection to assure the quality of work performed.
7. AEC reimburses you up to 50% of all qualifying expenses with a maximum rebate of \$500.00 (some limits apply)

** To qualify for rebate, steps 2-5 must be completed within 90 days.*

What Items are NOT eligible for Rebates?

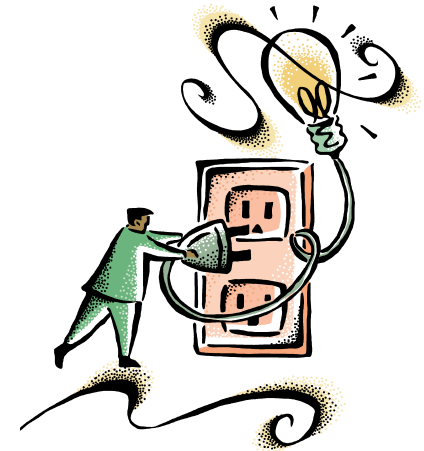
- ▶ Water Heaters (Including Tankless)
- ▶ Dishwashers
- ▶ Refrigerators
- ▶ Room Air Conditioners
- ▶ Programmable Thermostats (on existing HVAC)
- ▶ Window Film / Solar Sunscreen
- ▶ Radiant Barriers
- ▶ Clothes Washers
- ▶ Clothes Dryers
- ▶ Insulated Garage Doors
- ▶ Storm Doors

How Do I Qualify?

1. Must agree to an in-home evaluation, completed by a AEC approved evaluator.
2. Must be a stick-built residential home (single family) and have electric service with AEC for a minimum of one year.
3. Must not have participated in the heat pump loan program at this address within the last 6 months.
4. Must use AEC approved qualified weatherization contractors. (some work can be completed by homeowner with pre-approval from AEC)

<u>Type of Project</u>	<u>Maximum Rebate</u>
Replacement Windows	\$500.00
Storm Windows	\$500.00
Duct Repair/ Replacement	\$500.00
Rehabilitation (glass replacement, door replacement, etc.)	\$250.00
Replace Heat Pump	\$250.00
Attic Insulation / Static Ventilation	\$500.00
Floor / Perimeter Insulation / Ground Cover	\$500.00
Knee Wall Insulation	\$500.00
Air Sealing	\$500.00
Homeowner-installed Improvements (caulk, Weather stripping, etc.)	\$250.00
HVAC Tune Up	\$150.00
