

Any AEC Member (or Solar Contractor) interested in installing distributed solar generation of less than 50kW to any local residential or commercial property served by AEC, should follow these procedures.

Step #1            Obtain the Application for Interconnection located on our website or contact our office  
                         Complete and sign the application and return it to [crose@aecoop.org](mailto:crose@aecoop.org)  
                         You must include remittance of the \$250 non-refundable application fee

Step #2            Obtain the Interconnection Agreement (Tier 1) located on our website or contact  
                         our office for assistance (865-475-2032 extension 1174)  
                         Complete and sign the agreement and return it to [crose@aecoop.org](mailto:crose@aecoop.org)

When AEC is in possession of a completed Application for Interconnection and the Interconnection Agreement and when required fees are paid; AEC will issue a notice to the solar contractor to proceed with construction / installation of the solar system.

When the solar contractor is ready for interconnection, they will move to step #3

Step #3            Must provide proof of insurance to AEC

Step #4            Must provide proof of TN State Electric Inspection

Step #             Must request AEC final inspection on a date and time when the solar contractor will be present on site. Upon passing inspection, written notice will be supplied for the system to begin generation
